Medical Aid in Dying (MAID) was selected as a 2024 Legislative Priority by CO-AGE members last July. CO-AGE (Coalition of Aging) is a subgroup of the Georgia Council on Aging (GCOA), a government aligned organization that advocates to improve the lives of aging Georgians.

Due to the complexity of the issue, members of the CO-AGE workgroup found it important to defer pursuit of legislative action until the 2025 General Assembly session. In the meantime, CO-AGE members have launched an educational campaign for 2024 so that the community can better understand the issue, have the opportunity to ask questions and engage in meaningful discourse before approaching the legislature to request a Study Committee in 2025. We will not have to go through the application and voting process again this year as MAID will automatically roll over to the CO-AGE 2025 Legislative Priorities List.

The MAID working group has finalized a PowerPoint for presentations, and is ready to begin scheduling for any group that is interested. Please join us in welcoming Dr. Jeremy Davis to GAELO's Board of Directors! Dr. Jeremy Davis is an Assistant Professor in the Department of Philosophy at the University of Georgia, and a Faculty Fellow at UGA's Institute for Artificial Intelligence. His scholarly research is broadly in applied ethics. His work in biomedical ethics has appeared in journals such as Bioethics, the Journal of Medical Ethics, Journal of Bioethical Inquiry, Cambridge Quarterly of Healthcare Ethics, and elsewhere. Broadly, Dr. Davis's work in this area defends a philosophically robust view of patient-centered care, which has important implications for expanding access to end-of-life options. In addition to his scholarly work, Dr. Davis is also an ethics consultant with Compass Ethics.

We are sad to announce that Lisa Kaufman has informed of us her decision to resign her board seat to focus her time on other endeavors. Her experience as a Death Doula and commitment to GAELO's cause were invaluable and she has the full gratitude of our organization for her contributions as a member on the board.
